Children's Leaders Conference

TRAINING & EQUIPPING LEADERS & PROTECTING CHILDREN

The Need

In the Amazon, 2 million people live in remote river villages scattered across vast jungles, with children among the most vulnerable. Many face poverty, lack of education, and early exposure to dangers like abuse, drugs, and promiscuity—some as young as age 12. Without guidance and protection, these children grow up in cycles of despair, often disconnected from hope and opportunities for a better life.

Healthy local churches are essential for breaking these cycles, offering advocacy for children that encompasses sharing the Gospel while providing life-saving guidance and protection. However, many children's ministry leaders in the jungle lack the resources and training to address the overwhelming challenges. With little support, these leaders are left to tackle urgent and complex issues on their own. Equipping and encouraging them is critical for building a new future for the children of the Amazon.

The Impact

Our annual Children's Ministry Leaders Conference provides these leaders with the tools, inspiration, and fellowship they need to disciple and protect over 1,700 children in 50 villages. In 2024, 70% of attendees were new, traveling days by boat to learn practical skills in child protection, navigating technology's influence, and combating drug trafficking. Sessions also emphasized holistic child advocacy, equipping leaders to meet both spiritual and physical needs.

Leaders shared how God moved powerfully in their lives, inspiring them to deepen their commitment to the children they serve. They returned home with training kits, food baskets, and flash drives filled with resources, ready to build bridges to children's families, improve church programs, and advocate for vulnerable youth.

By investing in these leaders, the conference ensures that children in remote villages are guided, loved, and protected. Through this effort, the light of the Gospel shines into the jungle, offering hope and salvation to the next generation.

The conference is partly funded by Brazilian partners, the remaining amount needed to run the conference annually is \$25,000. This provides 4 days of training for 125 participants.
