Transitional Living Home Improvements





The Need

JMI's Transitional Living Program serves some of the world's most vulnerable teenagers, offering them safety and hope in the face of significant risks, including trafficking and exploitation. This, our most intimate and high-impact work, takes place in four Transitional Living homes—two for boys and two for girls—located in the north and central regions of Moldova.

These homes, which have been well-loved and heavily used over the years, are now in need of critical repairs. Roofs leak, plumbing falters, and common areas require upgrades to remain sufficient. The needed improvements to these homes will be a tangible expression of God's love



and care for these teenagers, demonstrating that they are seen, valued, and worthy of living in spaces that reflect dignity and security.

The heart of this program's success is the presence of dedicated, long-term house parents who live in our homes and offer constant love, support, and guidance. These renovations are vital to retaining these compassionate, skilled individuals who make this work possible. Home improvements will provide the privacy and healthy boundaries necessary for both the teenagers and house parents to thrive.

The Impact

The Gospel's transformative power is evident in JMI's Transitional Living Program. Teenagers who once felt abandoned, unloved, and forgotten are reminded that they matter. In these homes, they receive the stability, love, and guidance needed to heal from past trauma and discover their God-given potential

With the safety and structure of a nurturing environment, these young people are equipped with the tools to succeed—practical life skills, education, spiritual growth, and emotional resilience. They gain the confidence to step into the world as thriving, hopeful individuals ready to contribute to their communities. Many of these teens become leaders in their churches, role models in their workplaces, and compassionate advocates for others who are vulnerable. Their transformation ripples out, influencing the next generation. By investing in much-needed renovations to these homes, we ensure this sacred work continues.



The Cost

JMI needs to raise \$225,000 to fund the improvements to our three homes that we own, which are estimated to cost \$75,000 each.


This includes:
